Conclusion and Follow-up to the Discussion Meetings Between Adult Support Groups and Unaccompanied Minors

Dear partners and collaborators of EURHOPE – “The EU as a Caring Home for Unaccompanied Minors”: The project activities took their usual break for the Christmas holidays, but only to return refreshed and ready to go.

All partners are working on finalizing Activity 3, the Artistic Project. We are also all compiling more data from the workshops held in October for dissemination work in the final stages of the project.

After the short Christmas break, the project continues in 2026 with the same perspective and enthusiasm as the first day. The discussion groups have now concluded, as we mentioned in our previous update. Each partner is focused on completing Activity 3, the art project, with their respective groups.

In Spain, we finalized the discussion group evaluations at the beginning of 2026 and began the art project with our group of children. Our project in Spain will involve creating an animated short film using a video editor. The children will contribute their ideas from the workshops to the creation of this short.

Two stories related to bullying have been created, with the children developing the characters and plot through drawings and crafts.

We are moving forward with the production of the short film, and as soon as we have the final product and the results, we will begin the final phase of the project and prepare for its completion in the coming months.

We are also starting to plan how to disseminate and share the results. In line with the sharing, we have started conversations between the partners to coordinate our final project meeting in Catania.



The methodology used to address these issues focused on the participation of minors and adults at a cross-sectoral level, through role-playing and open discussions.

This phase of the program will allow the discussion groups to begin their work, which they will present at the end of the program.
