Welcome to this new edition of the **EURHOPE Project Newsletter**, where we share the latest developments and achievements of our Erasmus+ initiative.

EURHOPE aims to strengthen **civic participation, resilience, and social inclusion for minors living outside their family environment**, promoting a stronger connection with European values and democratic participation.

We have now reached the last part of the project and the **artistic projects** that minors prepare together with adult volunteers are the final deliverables of the EURHOPE project. Minors have been asked to select one of the key European priorities and work together to develop a creative result (i.e. presentation, movies, podcast, etc). This process is very significant for the minors understanding and participation in modern European life, for multiple reasons: a. it helps them socialize more and practice collaboration towards a goal; b. it helps build social and relational capital among minors and among minors and positive adults; c. it helps minors internalize European values.

The development of creative projects has three stages: ideation/topic selection, production, and finalization. At this point, minor participants in all countries have already selected their topic, have discussed the type of creative output they want to develop, and work at full speed to produce it. More specifically:

Minors in **Italy**, working in different groups, have decided to address the topic of Active Citizenship. One of the groups works on developing a Zine, an anthology of autobiographical stories, while another has created a social urban vegetable garden and they work on a film that will show all the stages of this creation-from initiation to the collection of vegetables.

Minors in **Greece**, have decided to address the issues of Environment and Social Justice, have already finished shooting two different films, and now work on the post-production to finalize them.

Minors in **Spain**, have decided to address the issues of Bullying and Cyberbullying, and now work on developing a short movie that reveals the different realities of the topic.

We are very eager to see the output of all teams! The results will also be presented during the project's final event in Catania, Sicily in May. All products will also be uploaded to the project website.
