As part of the activities carried out by the EU Projects Department of Cuore Srl – Social Enterprise, part of the Solco Group, the Erasmus+ project “EURHOPE” was presented in a local event of promotion on 5th of May 2026 with a public of more than 60 people attending.

The project was created to respond to the educational and relational needs of vulnerable adolescents through innovative pathways based on educational relationships, active citizenship, and the creation of positive networks within the educational community. As highlighted during the presentation by the Manager of EU Projects Department, EURHOPE is part of a wider set of initiatives aimed at supporting disadvantaged young people and promoting educational and relational practices capable of strengthening wellbeing and social cohesion promoted by Cuore.

A European Project to Leave No One Behind

The project promotes:

- training pathways for positive adults and mentors;
- civic participation activities for minors;
- creative workshops and discussion moments on European topics;
- the development of social, relational, and citizenship skills.

The main objective is to encourage the creation of new positive relational networks, offering young people concrete opportunities to feel heard, actively participate in society, and build a more conscious vision of their future.

Dissemination and Local Impact

During the internal presentation organised by the EU Projects Department, it was underlined how European projects can generate a concrete impact not only at the international level, but also within local communities, through dissemination activities, promotion, and enhancement of project results.

In this context, EURHOPE represents a concrete example of European project design focused on:

- social inclusion;
- democratic participation;
- strengthening transversal competences;
- building more inclusive and sustainable educational communities.
