On May 7th and 8th, the partners gathered at the Metacometa Aps headquarters in Casa Nazareth-Viagrande for the final meeting and closing ceremony.

Final Meeting, May 7th

During the final meeting, each partner presented their project work, highlighting the results achieved and the involvement of minors through methodological approaches aimed at promoting **SOCIAL INCLUSION, DEMOCRATIC PARTICIPATION, and COMMUNITY INTEGRATION.**

Metacometa Aps, the event's host, presented its plan for promoting and disseminating the project's results, both within its own local area and at the European level, also highlighting the role of social media as a useful communication tool. Centro Studi presented the Methodological Handbook, detailing the contribution of each partner and the importance of shared project methodologies. Indipcie presented its website and the sections dedicated to news, defining the quality of the results. Arsis, along with all the partners, discussed the sustainability of the final results and the methodological approach. Cuore coordinated and managed the organization and administrative procedures accompanying the project's closure.

The day concluded with a social dinner for all the partners.



Final Event May 8 - Closing Ceremony The day began with the registration of participants and the launch of a Facebook Live broadcast to share the phases of the Erhope project with stakeholders, European associations, and interested parties. After a brief introductory presentation by the host organization, Indipcie presented the website and news section, describing the various sections where information on all project phases can be found; Cuore described the project toolkit and the tools supporting partners; Hellenic American Union presented the approaches used for developing life and digital skills; Centro Studi presented the Methodological Handbook, gathering the participation of all partners and integrating the project results. Finally, Arsis, Centro Studi, and Cordoba Acoge presented the project work created by minors and adults through presentation and description videos. Metacometa Aps illustrated its work with an outdoor demonstration.



On the same day, Metacometa Aps held an event to disseminate the results at local level, inviting neighboring schools, stakeholders, and representatives of local municipalities.



The day concluded with a shared lunch and the awarding of certificates.
