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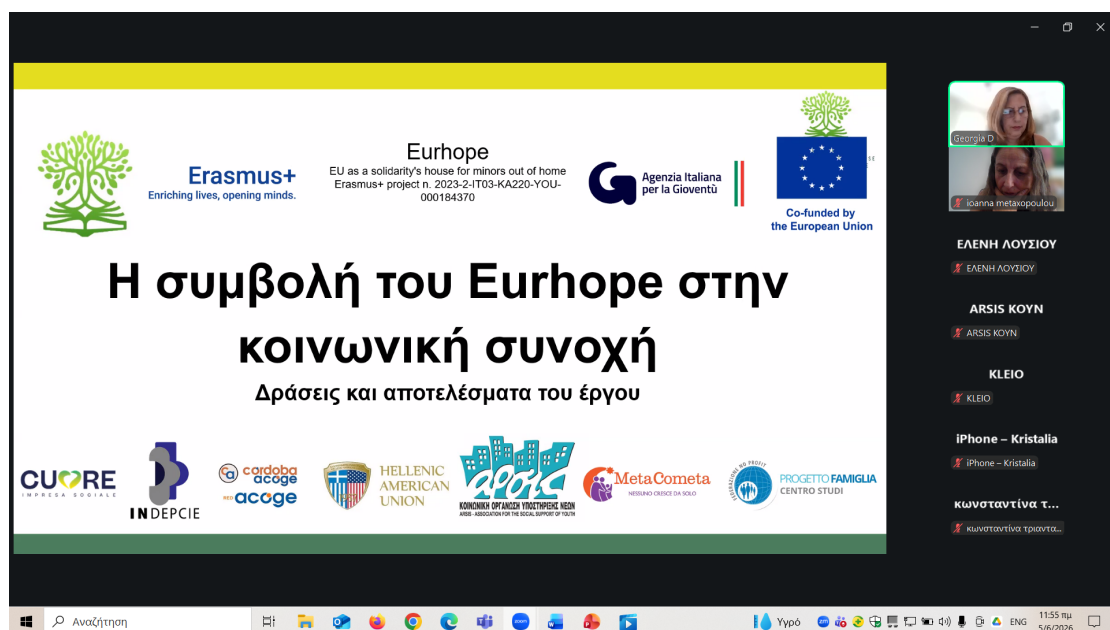

Welcome to this new edition of the EURHOPE project newsletter.

On June 5th Hellenic American Union and ARSIS hosted an online national event for the dissemination of the project results with Greek participants. The event was named “EURHOPE’s contribution to social cohesion” and it was held via zoom.



During the event the two organizations presented the project identity, partners and results, with an emphasis on Greek activities.

More specifically, Hellenic American Union presented key information on the project, stressing the collaboration between training and social organizations in all 3 countries; then provided an overview of the project’s objectives and results.

A more detailed presentation of the training material contents for minors and adults followed, noting that training materials were translated and localized in all partner languages, to reflect local specificities.

At this point, Arsis took over and presented local activities in three Greek cities, namely Thessaloniki, Ioannina and Kozani. It referred to the discussion groups with adults and minors around priority issues in the European Union and provided examples and pictures of the activities that were organized, like a mock municipality meeting and outdoor activities.

Then, Arsis explained that minors selected two priority topics, Environment and Social Justice to build their artistic projects, explained the way the minors decided to work and presented the two videos that the minors had prepared.

Just before the end of the presentation, Hellenic American Union presented the project website and explained the contents that the participants can study at their own time.

The last part of the event was devoted to questions and comments by the participants. One of the volunteer adults who worked with the minors throughout the project shared her experience and asked for the continuation of similar activities, as the results were very promising.

A total of 23 people participated in the event, among which were some of the positive adults who had worked with the minors in Greece, trainers, workers in other social organizations and people who are interested in the topic of social cohesion.
